***Additional details related to membership application, membership duration and renewal process**

Application for membership in the New Democratic Party of Prince Edward Island is open to anyone 14 years of age and older — regardless of race, ethnic background, colour, religion or religious belief, national origin or sex or sexual orientation — who undertakes to abide by the constitution and principles of the New Democratic Party of Prince Edward Island and who is not a member or supporter of any other political party.

Membership in the New Democratic Party of Prince

Edward Island is on a **calendar year** basis. A member shall be in good standing as long as payment of membership fees is **not more than three months in arrears**.

Any individual whose membership fees are more than three months in arrears (i.e. not paid by **April 1** of the following year) shall not be in good standing and membership shall cease.

However, an individual whose membership fees are **more than three months in arrears** may **renew** his or her membership

by completing a **Membership Renewal Form** and paying the appropriate membership fees if the completed Membership Renewal Form and fees are submitted in the **same calendar year** in which membership ceased.

To **renew** a membership **prior to membership expiration**, please contact the New Democratic Party of Prince Edward Island office using the information provided at the top of the front page and ask for a **Membership Renewal Form**.
